The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it, the world, and those who live in it, for he has founded it on the seas and established it on the rivers.- Psalm 24:1-2

Last week I announced that we will be spending more time focusing on stewardship of life. The word "stewardship" might be one of the most misused words in the church. When we use that word, most often we think that it has something to do with our finances or what we give to the church. We have used the word stewardship to talk about capital campaigns that raise money for the building. We have used the word stewardship to urge people to make or increase their financial pledges to the church. We have used the word stewardship to make sure that people understand the church's reliance on the giving of her members. While capital campaigns, pledges, and offerings are vital to the life of the congregation, that is a very narrow view of what it means to be a good steward.

Stewardship is about how we live our life. Much of the time we focus on finances, but stewardship includes our time, talents, and everything else we can use for God. While we like to think of stewardship as what we choose to give to God, perhaps we need to focus more on what we retain. Perhaps being a better steward means that we think more about why we hold back the things we do.

For the next several weeks, during our Wednesday night Bible studies, we will be talking about living a life of stewardship and examining what we choose to give to God and what we prefer to keep for ourselves. I hope you will join us as we seek to offer more of ourselves to God. Again, I promise your wallets are safe.


