Easter will be here before you know it. We have numerous opportunities for you to worship and remember the works of Christ during Holy Week.

We are excited to announce that the Community Holy Week Services will be returning this week and that we will be hosting them at Cookeville First Cumberland Presbyterian Church. April 3-7, you are invited to join us at 12:00pm each day for a 30-minute worship service that will be led by different ministers from our community. A sack lunch will be available each day.

Additionally, we will have a Maundy Thursday service at 7:00pm on April 6<sup>th</sup>. During the service we will celebrate the sacrament of Holy Communion.


