#### From Your Minister - Christian Smith

"Let us approach with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful." – Hebrews 10:22-23

This past Sunday I tried to bring a small part of the Cumberland Presbyterian General Assembly meeting back to Cookeville. I used the same Call to Worship that the assembly used during opening worship. I used the same scripture and theme that we used throughout the week in Denton. Then, finally, we closed the service with "Blessed Assurance", which was the same hymn the youth at the meeting used for the devotional they led.

That hymn has been running through my head a lot lately. It is a hymn that many of us grew up singing in the church. I want to take a moment to make sure that we all know the history behind the hymn. "Blessed Assurance" was written by Fanny Crosby. She lost her sight at 6 weeks old and by age 6 she began writing poems and music. She wrote over 8,000 gospel songs and hymns during her life. She also wrote over 1,000 non-religious songs and four books of poetry.

One day Phoebe Knapp played Mrs. Crosby a new tune that she had written. Mrs. Knapp asked her what that tune brought to mind. It is said that Mrs. Crosby knelt in prayer and then responded, "blessed assurance, Jesus is mine." The two would continue to work together to add the remainder of the lyrics to this historic hymn.

Fanny Crosby gave us a great gift. She has shared with us words that remind us of how blessed we are. No matter what life may throw at us, we have assurance of something greater than anything this world can offer. No matter the difficulties we might face, we have that blessed assurance because we have the presence of the Christ who loves each of us.






The family of Sarah Joyce requests only that you bring a card to help celebrate her  $90^{th}$  birthday. If you are unable to attend, you may mail your card to:

We can't wait to celebrate with you!






