From Your Minister - Christian Smith

"The earth is the Lord's and all that is in it, the world, and those who live in it, for he has founded it on the seas and established it on the rivers."— Psalm 24:1

I just finished writing the sermon that I will preach at the funeral for Leo DePriest. I often have people inquire about how difficult it is to write a sermon for a funeral. The truth is, all of those sermons are difficult. Some are difficult because I may not have known the person well, and I always strive to personalize those sermons for the person whose life we are celebrating. Others are difficult because I know the person very well, and as I prepare the message, there is a flood of memories that come to me and I do not have time to share everything that comes to mind.

Leo certainly fell in the second category. I have witnessed and I have heard the stories of Leo's love and compassion and sacrifice for others. I have witnessed and have heard the stories of Leo's joy for life. Those memories are special and are certainly memories and lessons that I will not forget. The time that we have with our loved ones and the lessons that we learn from them are gifts from God.

As people who are called to be stewards of all of God's gifts, we need to be caretakers of those memories. We are not caretakers if we keep those memories to ourselves. We are good stewards of those memories when we allow ourselves to learn from them and grow because of them. We are good stewards when we take the memories of the good that we saw in others, and we emulate that in our lives. When we are good stewards of the memories of our loved ones, those people live on in the world through us.


